During the academic year 2025–26, which marked the foundation year of GS College of Pharmacy and the inaugural batch of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) and Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharm.) programmes, the institution achieved a significant milestone with a total enrollment of 110 students across its academic programmes. The college recorded an overall student success rate of approximately 68%, reflecting the institution's commitment to quality education, academic excellence, and effective faculty support systems.

Programme-wise enrollment details are as follows:

- ✓ Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.): 61 students admitted against an approved intake capacity of 100.
